MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT





TOUT POUR LA MUSIQUE

Organized as part of the Saint-Jean-Baptiste Day, It took place on Thursday, June 22nd, at The Exchange in Regina, in partnership with the Fransaskois Cultural Council. The 2023 edition featured an artistic program that highlighted the diversity of Francophone culture in Canada. With financial support from the Government of Canada and produced by Productions Rivard, this event invited all Canadians to come together to celebrate and demonstrate their pride and solidarity with the Francophonie.

Spectator Participation :

- On June 22nd, the show, featuring **19+ artists** from the Canadian Francophonie, attracted **60 spectators** in Regina.
- **935 people** attended one of **13 in-person screenings** of the show, organized in collaboration with local community organizations.
- The live broadcast of the show was watched by **7 000 viewers** on UnisTV.
- The 5 subsequent re-airings of the show accumulated **49 000 views**.

Media and Digital Reach :

- Social media engagement was exceptional, with a substantial increase in reach; **257 000** on Facebook et **2 800** on Instagram.
- Over **a hundred** mentions of Tout pour la musique in French and English media (radio, newspapers, and television) across the country helped reach a large segment of the population.

As a co-founder of the Linguistic Duality Network, which aims to foster a positive appreciation for Canada's official languages and promote linguistic duality

Linguistic Duality Day, organized in collaboration with Canadian Heritage.

The Linguistic Duality Network collaborated with the Council of the Network of Official Languages Champions to organize a youth panel and a webinar on September 14th, titled **Official Languages Day: Our Languages, A Gateway to the World**. This event featured Canadian artists who delivered unforgettable cultural and musical performances.

The panel and webinar recorded over **2,700 attendants**, including **740** from the general public. The Official Languages Day page on the Linguistic Duality Network website received approximately **730 visits** from August to October 2023.

Celebrate Official Languages Day in schools!

This year, the Linguistic Duality Network provided a range of educational kits for elementary and secondary school classes, featuring activities centred around Official Languages Day. These kits were distributed to over **100 teachers** across Canada, reaching more than **3000 students**. The project had an exceptional impact, drawing a remarkable number of participants.



From March 1st to 31st, the 26th edition of the Rendez-vous de la Francophonie took place under the theme «Launch into Discovery»! With a vibrant and inclusive atmosphere, the RVF team organized a variety of activities for all ages, available both in person across communities and virtually on RVF.ca.

Spokespersons Micheline Marchildon, a Franco-Manitoban comedian, and LeFLOFRANCO, a Franco-Ontarian hip-hop artist, engaged audiences and celebrated Francophone culture throughout the month of March with great enthusiasm.

Francophone comedians performed **11 shows** in front of **2 000 people** **live audience** as a part of the RVF comedy tour.

The RVF showcased the tour of LeFLOFRANCO, co-spokesperson and Franco-Ontarian hip-hop artist. **Over 7 000 students** were reached across **six provinces**. Through engaging with these young audiences, the tour promoted Francophone culture and inspired the next generation through LeFLOFRANCO's music and messages. This initiative not only strengthened the artist's presence within Canada's Francophone community but also showcased and celebrated the country's rich cultural and linguistic diversity.




Microgrants

The RVF provided **35 microgrants** to non-profit organizations to help them organize or enhance a local event as part of the 26th edition of the RVF. A total of **\$59,000** was distributed, increasing participation by over **12,000 new attendees** at these activities.



RVF INVESTMENTS



- 177 800 \$ provided to communities and non-profit organizations

The Youth Forum is an inclusive and innovative experience bringing together several young leaders from various Canadian provinces, all dedicated to promoting diversity and inclusion. From March 18th to 20th, participants engaged in a variety of workshops, took part in enriching discussions, and attended inspiring conferences. The recent edition saw the participation of over 60 young adults from different regions of Canada, highlighting the growing importance of this initiative.
